MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Master’s degree in Social Work from a program approved by the Council on Social Work Education. Considerable experience (48 months or more) as a social worker in the mental health field, including some (12 months or more) supervisory experience.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have or be eligible for licensure as a graduate social worker as issued by the Alabama Board of Social Work. Eligible employees must obtain licensure within one year of appointment date in order to maintain employment.

KIND OF WORK: Performs psychosocial assessments/social histories, post-hospitalization planning/implementation, and therapy/casework for hospitalized, seriously and chronically mental ill, adult persons. Contributes to the development, revision, and monitoring of individualized treatment plans. Provides basic social work services for hospitalized patients and their families with patient progress documented. Communicates with CMHC staff on hospitalized patients to provide continuity of care. Communicates with families and/or significant others regarding hospitalized patients to educate and involve them in treatment and aftercare planning. Oversees Peer Specialist Services by assigning treatment groups and individual sessions with mentally ill adults and monitor and evaluate services provided. Provides social work supervision (administrative, educational, and supportive) to all assigned social workers in regularly scheduled supervisory conferences. Demonstrates professional growth and clinical competency by attending and actively participating in discipline meetings, supervisory consultation meetings, and social work in-service programs.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES: Knowledge of community resources for the mentally ill. Knowledge of clinical and crisis interventions. Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing. Ability to make clinical assessments. Ability to keep accurate records and write reports. Ability to communicate effectively with all levels of staff, patients, and families in a professional and courteous manner at all times.

METHOD OF SELECTION: Applicants will be rated based on an evaluation of their education, training, and experience, and should provide adequate work history identifying experiences related to duties and minimum qualifications as mentioned above. All relevant information is subject to verification. Drug screenings and security clearance will be conducted on prospective applicants being given serious consideration for employment and whose job requires direct contact with clients.

HOW TO APPLY: Use an official application for Professional Employment (Exempt Classification) which may be obtained from our website at www.mh.alabama.gov. **Only work experience detailed on the application will be considered.** Applications should be submitted by the deadline to be considered. Announcements open until filled will remain open until a sufficient applicant pool is obtained. Applications should be submitted as soon as possible to ensure the application will be considered for the position. Copies of License/Certifications should be uploaded with your application. A copy of the academic transcript is required. Appointment of successful candidate will be conditional based on receipt of the official transcript provided by the school, college, or university.
