MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Graduation from an approved school of medicine.
- Successful completion of a residency program in psychiatry as approved by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology and recognized by the American Medical Association (AMA) or the American Osteopathic Association.
- Must be board certified in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be eligible for or possess a license as issued by the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners.
- Must have Federal Controlled Substance Registration Certificate.
- Must possess a controlled substance certificate issued by the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners.

KIND OF WORK

• Serves as the treatment team leader in evaluating, implementing, reviewing, and updating treatment plans for individual patients and groups of patients.



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- Serves as primary psychotherapist in treating/evaluating individuals and groups of patients.
- Selects, prescribes, adjusts, and reviews medications for patients.
- Conducts comprehensive psychiatric examinations to include the mental status examination and annual psychiatric examinations (as needed).
- Writes/composes documents for mental status/psychiatric evaluations, treatment plans, progress notes and reports.
- Provides psychiatric opinion/consultation.
- Serves on Bryce Hospital committees, medical staff committees, and discipline committees.
- Serves as psychiatric OD on a rotational basis.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Knowledge of laws, rules, and regulations to include The Joint Commission, Alabama Medicaid Agency, and other regulatory agencies.
- Knowledge of mental conditions such as psychosis and behavioral disorders.
- Knowledge of pharmacology / psychopharmacology such as anti-psychotics and psychotropics.
- Knowledge of treatment strategies.
- Knowledge of psychological principles needed to implement into a program of treatment / planning for clients.
- Ability to make clinical assessments, interprets responses both verbal and non-verbal, gathers clinical data, and diagnoses illnesses.
- Ability to communicate effectively, verbally and in writing.
- Ability to work with other professionals and community agencies in a courteous and professional manner.
- Ability to work with adult and geriatric patients.
- High moral and ethical character required for licensure.

METHOD OF SELECTION

- Applicants will be rated based on an evaluation of their job-related training, abilities, experience, and education, and should provide adequate work history identifying experiences related to the duties and minimum qualifications as mentioned above.
- All relevant information is subject to verification.
- Drug screening and security clearances will be conducted on prospective applicants being given serious consideration for employment whose job requires direct contact with patients.
