 and suicide risk assessments.
- Participates in treatment planning for adult patients including participation in treatment team review meetings, individual treatment planning conferences, and other team meetings.
- Supervises non-doctoral psychology staff members, students, and interns as assigned.
- Assesses, interprets, and monitors data related to the provision of services.
- Provides leadership as a member of the Clinical Management Team.
- Obtains and maintains state licensure as a psychologist, certification as a forensic examiner, and obtain and maintain membership on the Bryce Hospital medical staff.
- Ensures compliance with hospital standards.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Knowledge of treatment strategies, various diagnostic disorders and categories, psychological assessment interventions, and conflict intervention techniques.
- Ability to interact with patients, families, and other professionals in a courteous and professional manner.
- Ability to make clinical assessments and decisions, conduct therapy, and supervise subordinates.
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to use personal computers and various software programs.
- Ability to ensure compliance with hospital standards.
