MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

• Graduation with a Master's Degree or higher advanced degree in Nursing, with a clinical specialty in the appropriate area of practice. Must have successfully completed a Nurse Practitioner program recognized and approved by the Alabama Board of Nursing.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

• Possession of a current advanced practice nursing certification as a Certified Registered Nurse Practitioner (CRNP) granted by the Alabama Board of Nursing in the clinical specialty appropriate with the area of practice.

KIND OF WORK

- Obtains a comprehensive psychiatric history and records findings upon admission.
- Completes mental status exam, psychiatric evaluation, treatment plans, suicide/violence risk screening and progress notes.



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- Orders, performs, where indicated, and interprets screening and diagnostic procedures/tests in collaboration with physicians.
- Develops and implements a plan of care, including differential diagnosis and treatment options.
- Implements, as needed, emergency protocols.
- Writes and transcribes orders for medications and treatments.
- Collaborates with other members of the treatment team.
- Participates in the development, utilization, and revision of practice guidelines.
- Co-manages care for patients with selected health complications, in collaboration with the physician.
- Arranges referrals, as appropriate, to other community resources and members of the health care team.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Knowledge of general and specific psychiatric/medical diagnoses and treatment specific to the population served.
- Knowledge of principles and practices of clinical assessment, common health problems, mental health issues, clinical consultation, and continuity of patient care.
- Knowledge of common medications/pharmaceutical treatments and their interactions.
- Knowledge of basic laboratory work and radiological tests.
- Ability to work effectively with the population served.
- Ability to respond well to emergencies in a stressful environment and handle potentially volatile situations in a calm, decisive manner.
- Ability to develop and interpret medical and psychiatric histories, conduct psychiatric assessments, and evaluate client behavior.
- Ability to develop accurate and concise reports.
- Ability to document and manage client file information in a complete and accurate manner.

METHOD OF SELECTION

- Applicants will be rated based on an evaluation of their job-related training, abilities, experience, and education, and should provide adequate work history identifying experiences related to the duties and minimum qualifications as mentioned above.
- All relevant information is subject to verification.
- Drug screening and security clearances will be conducted on prospective applicants being given serious consideration for employment whose job requires direct contact with patients.
