Minimum Qualifications

Master's degree in Social Work from a program approved by the Council on Social Work Education.

Key Responsibilities

- Performs psychological assessments/social histories for hospitalized seriously and chronically mentally ill adults.
- Contributes to the development, revision and monitoring of individualized treatment plans for hospitalized seriously mentally ill adult patients.
- Performs post hospitalization planning and implementation for hospitalized seriously and chronically mentally ill adults.
- Conducts therapeutic group and individual therapy sessions with mentally ill adults and provides casework in accordance with established guidelines and appropriate protocol.
- Provides direct treatment and social work services for seriously and chronically mentally ill adults.
- Communicates with CMHC staff on seriously and chronically mentally ill adults to provide continuity of care.
- Communicates with families and significant others to provide educate and aftercare planning.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities (KSAs)

- Knowledge of clinical and crisis intervention.
- Knowledge of the Joint Commission and the Centers for Medicare/Medicaid Standards.
- Ability to read and comprehend documents such as social history, psychological assessments, data, court orders, etc.
- Ability to make clinical assessments.
- Ability to interact professionally with patients, families and other individuals.
- Ability to keep accurate records and prepare reports.
- Ability to communicate effectively, verbally and in writing.

Necessary Special Requirements

- Must have or be eligible for licensure as graduate social worker as issued by the Alabama Board of Social Worker.

- Eligible employees must obtain licensure within one year of appointment date in order to maintain employment.
