Doctorate degree in Psychology.

Key Responsibilities

- Prescribes, provides, and supervises direct care services for adult patients.
- Provides group and individual therapy and crisis management programs.
- Conducts initial psychological assessments, psychological assessment updates, psychological testing, forensic evaluations, Hospital Review Board evaluations, violence risk assessments, and suicide risk assessments.
- Participates in treatment planning for adult patients including participation in treatment team review meetings, individual treatment planning conferences, and other team meetings.
- Supervises non-doctoral psychology staff members, students, and interns as assigned.
- Assesses, interprets, and monitors data related to the provision of services.
- Provides leadership as a member of the Clinical Management Team.
- Obtains and maintains state licensure as a psychologist, certification as a forensic examiner, and obtain and maintain membership of the Bryce Hospital medical staff.
- Ensures compliance with hospital standards.

- Knowledge of treatment strategies, various diagnostic disorders and categories, psychological assessment instruments, and conflict intervention techniques.
