KIND OF WORK: Performs nursing assessments on patients, utilizing professional nursing skills and techniques. Develops and implements Nursing Plans of Care based on individual patient needs and concerns. Provides guidance, teaching and direct supervision as needed to assure maintenance of nursing care standards in the delivery of patient treatment. Teaches and supervises program staff in all record-keeping and documenting pertinent information to nursing care. Prepares and administers prescribed medications and treatments. Assures that physician's orders are transcribed correctly and assumes responsibility to assure that these are carried out. Recommends, assist in and administers disciplinary action as is deemed necessary. Performs other related duties as assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Ability in caring for forensic patients; strong assessment skills; ability to intervene appropriately in crisis situations; familiarity with Nursing Process and ability to apply it to individual needs of patients. Good writing skills.

METHOD OF SELECTION: Applicants will be rated on the basis of an evaluation of their training, experience and education, and should provide adequate work history identifying experiences related to the duties and minimum qualifications as mentioned above. All relevant information is subject to verification. Drug screening required.
