MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Doctorate degree in Psychology with considerable (48 months or more) clinical and administrative experience in psychological treatment and assessment. *Preference will be given to candidates with one or more years' experience in forensics and/or forensic training.*

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Possession of licensure as a Psychologist as issued by the Alabama Board of Examiners in Psychology.

KIND OF WORK: Responsible for ensuring that departmental, divisional and facility policies are followed; assist in developing budgets; develop plans for psychology services and provide administrative supervision to psychology services. Will serve on committees assigned. Provide clinical expertise in area of discipline and perform forensic evaluations as needed. Train and instruct forensic examiners and manage the statewide-regionalized forensic evaluation contracts.
