MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from an accredited school of nursing and three years’ experience as an RN, **OR** graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with a degree in nursing and two years’ experience as an RN.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Possession of a certificate of registration to practice nursing as issued by the Alabama Board of Nursing.

KIND OF WORK: This position is a professional, supervisory position, which will serve as the Relief Shift Supervisor and ensure proper staffing for shift. Will provide direct, individualized care to patients and review nursing plans of care. Intervenes in crisis situations. Reports pertinent information about patient’s condition and behavior. Supervises and evaluates employee performance. Provides in-service to staff as needed. Serves on committees and project groups as assigned. Performs other related duties.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES: Ability in caring for forensic patients; strong assessment skills; ability to intervene appropriately in crisis situations; familiarity with Nursing Process and ability to apply it to individual needs of patients and strong supervisory skills. Ability to express ideas concisely orally and in writing.

METHOD OF SELECTION: Applicants will be rated based on an evaluation of their training, experience, and education, and should provide adequate work history identifying experiences related to the duties and minimum qualifications as mentioned above. All relevant information is subject to

verification. Drug screening required. Security Clearances will be conducted on prospective applicants being given serious consideration for employment and whose job requires direct contact with clients.
