MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

 Possession of a current advanced practice nursing certification as a Certified Registered Nurse Practitioner (CRNP) granted by the Alabama Board of Nursing in the clinical specialty appropriate with the area of practice.

KIND OF WORK

• Obtains psychiatric assessment upon admission.



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- Develops individualized treatment plans.
- Selects appropriate medication based on diagnosis, monitors for side effects and makes adjustments.
- Documents completely with clarity and accurately recording patient presentations, diagnoses, treatment plans, and progress notes.
- Monitors lab information, including therapeutic drug monitoring (TDM), metabolic side effects, and neuroleptic malignant syndrome (NMS).
- Obtains consent on all patients for medications/procedures/capacity to handle daily affairs, including finances.
- Communicates clearly and concisely with patients, families and other healthcare providers and provides timely and accurate information.
- Performs other related duties necessary to the effective operations of the facility.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Knowledge of general and specific psychiatric diagnoses and treatment specific to the population served.
- Knowledge of principles and practices of clinical assessment, common health problems, mental health issues, clinical consultation and continuity of patient care.
- Knowledge of common medications/pharmaceutical treatments and their interactions
- Knowledge of basic laboratory work.
- Ability to work effectively with the population served.
- Abilit to respond well to emergencies in a stressful environment and handle potentially volatile situations in a calm, decisive manner.
- Ability to develop and interpret medical and psychiatric histories, conduct psychiatric assessments and evaluate client behavior.
- Ability to communicate with/educate/inform clients, their families, and staff.
- Ability to develop accurate/concise reports, and document and manage client file information.

METHOD OF SELECTION

- Applicants will be rated based on an evaluation of their job-related training, abilities, experience, and education, and should provide adequate work history identifying experiences related to the duties and minimum qualifications as mentioned above.
- All relevant information is subject to verification.
- Drug screening and security clearances will be conducted on prospective applicants being given serious consideration for employment whose job requires direct contact with patients.
